



VISCOSITECTURE

Our lives in the city are in many ways defined by the spaces created within it. Open, confined, oppressive, tranquil, imposing or liberating. As air flows through the spaces constructed in the city, so society drifts through concrete tributaries cut in deep structural valleys and swirls in the openness of public space. Our lives, routines and daily cognition connecting through the city as a viscose entity. Paths, structures, emotions and desires touched and shaped by the disruption of flow and rhythm focused by architectural space.

VISCOSITECTURE is the physical representation of a period of research into the effects of architecture on our viscose existence in the spaces it creates. The translation of physical, psychological and emotional maps into new forms of connected spaces that develop over time, altering the viewer's experiential relationship between them whilst offering a space for the contemplation of the complexity of the effects of architectural space on our daily existence.

Fel symudir aer trwy'r gwagleoedd a strwythur o fewn y ddinas, felly mae cymdeithas yn llifo trwy wythien concrit wedi'i dorri'n gyoedd dwfn strwythrol a throeliadau agoredrwydd gwagleoedd cyhoeddus. Ein bywydau, arferion ac ymwybyddiaeth ddyddiol wedi eu cysylltu trwy'r ddinas fel bodolaeth fiscos. Llwybrau, adeiladweithiau, emosiynau ac awyddfryd wedi eu cyffwrdd a'u siapio gan afonyddwch llif a rhythm wedi eu ffocysu gan wagle pensaerniol.

Cynrychiolaeth ffisegol o gyfnod ymchwil mewn i effeithiau pensaerniaeth ar ein bodolaeth fiscos yn y gwagleoedd mae'n creu yw VISCOSITECTURE. Cyfeithiad mapiau ffisegol, seicolegol ac emosiynol i ffurfiaw newydd o wagleoedd cysylltiol sydd yn datblygu dros amser, yn newid perthynas profiadaethol y gwyliwr wrth gynnig gwagle i ystyriaeth cymhlethdod effeithiau gwagle pensaerniol ar ein bodolaeth ddyddiol.

Transforming both visually and sonically throughout its duration, VISCOSITECTURE features 4 phases, beginning on 9th September 2016. Phase 2 can be experienced from 27th September, Phase 3 from 11th October and Phase 4 from 1st November. The show finishes with a closing event on the evening of the 18th November.

Jason&Becky are collaborative artists currently living and working in the European Union.

Having spent the summer of 2016 in Venice on a WAI funded residency responding to the Architecture Biennale, their conversation will reflect on issues raised as part of Mission Gallery's CIVIC project.

This recent work encompasses a reconnection with the material of handmade, mouth-blown glass, concentrating on the almost spiritual relation between light and the intense colour transmitted through flashed glass. Ongoing narratives express my relationship with my native landscape and the quality of its mark on my psyche, through pencil, brush and light.

Mission Gallery is one of Wales' most inspirational spaces for the contemporary arts. Mission Gallery has developed a reputation for dynamic and distinctive programming, to present excellence across the visual arts, applied arts and craft, from across Wales and beyond.

We are located on Swansea Marina near the City Centre, a 15 minute walk from Swansea Train Station and a 10 minute walk from Swansea's central bus station. Pay & display car parks are situated close by, with limited free 3 hour parking outside the gallery. Access is by one-step entry from pavement level through to our main entrance. There is level access throughout the gallery spaces, with education based on the first floor. A wheelchair ramp is also available on request.
